

Assembly Instructions for the Large Cargo Basket



Materials Needed

- Connect+ Large Cargo Basket (included in the box)
- Three black rods
- Six M4x10mm screws (short)
- Four phillips head screws (long)
- Eight washers (optional)
- · Connect+ latch attachment
- · Basket plate
- · Four black bolts
- Basket lining and cargo net
- Screwdriver
- Ride1Up Hex Key Set (provided with bike)

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Assemble the Basket Frame

- 1. Insert the three black rods into one side of the basket.
- 2. Place the other half of the basket on top, ensuring it is fully attached.

Step 2: Secure the Basket Frame

- 1. Twist the rods to align the holes properly before inserting the bolts.
- 2. Take the Six M4x10mm screws (short) and screw them into the rod inserts of the basket using a hex key.





STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Step 3: Install the Connect+ Attachment

- Place the Connect+ latch attachment inside the basket to rest on top of the 6 tabs of the basket, ensuring the Connect+ mechanism is positioned towards the front. (see figure 1 for reference. Note: figure is from small basket accessory)
- 2. Place the black basket plate on top of the Connect+ attachment, inside the constructed basket, and align the holes.
- 3. Take the six phillips head screws and insert them through the basket plate inserts, Connect+ tab inserts and thread screws into the basket frame to ensure all three pieces (basket frame, Connect+ Latch and basket plate) are connected. (Optional: Use washers for the two front and rear bolts)

Step 4: Attach the Basket Lining and Cargo Net

- Using the velcro flaps, secure the basket lining along the edge of the basket.
- 2. Attach the cargo net over the top for added security.

Step 5: Attach the Basket to Your Bike

- 1. Use the Connect+ system to attach the basket securely.
- 2. Push down until you hear a click, confirming it is locked in place.

Step 6: Removing the Basket

- 1. To remove the basket, pull the Connect+ latch located under the basket.
- 2. Lift the basket off the rack.

Final Steps & Review

- Ensure all bolts are tightened securely.
- Test the basket attachment by pulling gently to confirm it is locked in place.
